Activities and experience of the organisation:

Our team members have worked and participated informally in many international projects since 2012. We have worked hard on projects related to the activities of the association, which was officially registered in 2015, for the past 6 years and all of us have the skills and competencies in working with youngsters. We have sent more than 600 young people to numerous projects under the program "Erasmus+", which took place in the countries of Spain, North Macedonia, Turkey, Romania, Latvia, Estonia, the UK, Cyprus, Italy, Portugal, Malta, Hungary, Lithuania, Austria, Germany, Greece, Croatia, Albania, Poland, Slovakia, France, Indonesia, Dominican Republic, Georgia, Tunisia, Jordan, Kenya and others. All of these projects are in the area of human and women rights, FGM, migration and refugees, violence, education, recycling, environment, entrepreneurship, sports and healthy lifestyles, globalization and many other topics. Under the "Youth in Action" program we have developed and managed projects in North Macedonia, Serbia, Moldova, Ukraine, Georgia and Armenia in the fields of Education, Culture, Sport, Environment, Social inclusion, and Social Media. Since 2016 we have hosted 79 short-term and 4 long-term EVS volunteers, while we sent 5 long-term and 1 short-term EVS volunteer.

Experience in Vocational Education and Training (Erasmus+ VET):

Our organization works on new vocational education and training projects as a practice and practical training/work for young people. All vocational schools provide their students with adequate conditions and premises for the implementation of the practical training segment of their educational activities. The participating students in these projects have the chance to be part of international mobility and obtain the necessary practical skills as well as experience in the area they are studying in. The students, as the main target group of these projects, are coming from schools that do not lack behind in providing theoretical knowledge. Schools do the necessary to improve the process of matching this theoretical knowledge with practical training in an institution like the hosting partners. The work is well organized, structured and implemented so their training will be the same. The period that the pupils will spend abroad will boost their personal development, apart from their professional. The main objective is that, with the activities foreseen for implementation in our projects, we will enable the students to gain new knowledge from practical training in the area of their expertise. This main objective can be divided into the following sub-segments which are defining the idea for this project more clearly:

- providing students with possibilities for international practical training;
- providing students with possibilities for enhancement of their language skills via communication in a foreign language and using professional terminology;
- providing the possibility for the students to experience life in another country as well in a specific, international environment;
- providing the opportunity for intercultural learning in a multicultural environment;
- expanding the possibilities for future common activities between the partners from Bulgaria and other countries.

During our activities, we have implemented many projects with the participation of pupils coming from technical and vocational schools. We also had the pleasure of working with facilitators, instructors and employees of local Training Centers for Teachers. Being a foreign partner, our task is to prepare an appropriate program and provide appropriate adjustments to the needs of the

beneficiaries of internships. Our goal is to place students in real working conditions as they cooperate with smaller and larger companies, companies and consortia that can provide beneficiaries with maximum conditions for their professional development. We also aim to organize practices, so the young people can gain new experience not only practically but also to improve their language skills. The companies where we place trainees have a great culture and organization of work are firmly rooted in the Bulgarian market, they cooperate with foreign partners, so they can maximize their potential and above all, offer the trainees excellent conditions for professional and language development. The students receive different certificates depending on the experience type (YouthPass, ICDET pass, Europass and etc.) at the end of practice that confirms their gained skills. Due to many years of experience in organizing practice for students of technical and vocational schools, we at ICDET can prepare suitable internship programs. In the course of practice, the students will learn the exact nature of their field of work. Our organization focuses on professional development but also personal. Beneficiaries have the chance to broaden their horizons, meet peers from other European Union countries, and practice language skills and interpersonal skills. In the past 3 years, we have not only focused on the mobility of students, but our association also has implemented many projects of strategic partnerships aimed at implementing new educational solutions (for example e-learning) in the area of vocational training. Seeing the enormous need for change in the education and labour markets, ICDET engages itself in strategic projects that emphasize development and introduce significant changes in the European Education and Labour Markets.

ICDET has 6 successfully hosted Erasmus+ VET Vocational education and training projects for the period February – April 2018, in the field of medicine, mechanics, hairdressing and cosmetics, electronics and dentistry, in which 150 students and 40 teachers participated.

Experience in Erasmus+ KA2:

ICDET finished the project "DEVELOPMENT OF CAPACITIES FOR WORK WITH (I)MIGRANTS" under the Key Action 2 Cooperation for innovation and the exchange of good practices. Partners are from North Macedonia, Indonesia, Bulgaria, Germany and the „(i)Migration + action = Global reaction“, Capacity Building for Youth in ACP countries, Latin America and Asia with partners from Germany, Estonia, Spain, Indonesia, Dominican Republic and Kenya.

Currently, we are partners for 3 trans-continental projects on various fundamental topics under KA:2, “Erasmus+”: Capacity Building for Youth in neighbouring and enlargement countries/ Capacity Building in the field of youth - South Mediterranean Youth Window – Tunisia - “Standing up 2 FGM”; KA2 – Cooperation for innovation and the exchange of good practices -Capacity Building in the field of Youth “Social Media literacy for #WOMEN RIGHTS” with partners from Spain (applicant), Dominican Republic, Indonesia, Thailand and Cape Verde; Capacity Building in the field of youth - Eastern Partnership - Civil Society Fellowships for youth “Gender watch - raising capacities of work with media” with partners from Georgia (applicant), Ukraine, Moldova, Spain and Lithuania.

We were partners for KA2 “Youth of the World: the transformative power of global education (YoW)” Strategic Partnerships in the Field of Youth; KA2 “Agro-youth Entrepreneurship and pan European Cooperation”; KA202 - Strategic Partnerships for vocational education and training project “Cheese and Wine and Tourism will shine! - Support to young cheese and wine sommeliers from EU.”; Strategic partnership project KA204 – strategic partnership for adult education “Computer literacy for the new age”; KA2 Advanced Research and Training project “Sustainable Measures for Advanced Research and Training (S.M.A.R.T.)”; KA2 - Cooperation for Innovation and the

Exchange of Good Practices KA204 - Strategic Partnerships for adult education “Enhancing new-age skills for adults”, Capacity Building for Youth in neighbouring and enlargement countries/Capacity Building in the field of youth - Eastern Partnership - Civil Society Fellowships for youth “European response in migration and integration (ERMI)”.

Experience in Erasmus+ KA3:

As a result of our long-term partnership with Sofia Municipality, we were also a partner of a KA:3 project "BE PART OF EUROPE" which was held in Cagliari, Italy. The project stemmed from the need to support young people in creating a political consciousness, to encourage the rapprochement and reconciliation of youth to Politics, institutions and policymakers. It was organized as a transnational meeting where the young Italians and Bulgarians, together with policymakers in both countries, discussed how, within their own countries, youth policies are dealt with and what are the best practices at the European level, to promote the emergence of structured dialogue and be able to contribute to the development of European youth policy. The methodology used for the week included: the OST, roundtables, and workshops.

ICDET is also a partner in KA3 – Support for Policy Reform Civil Society Cooperation in the field of Youth “Tune”. The mission of the EU-wide Network is to recognize youth as the base of sustainable civil society and to engage, connect and empower young people across Europe.

Experience in European Generation (Eugen):

Since 2017, ICDET is a host organization for EUGEN trainees. Since 2018 we have hosted more than 20 interns. The interns were involved in the work of the organization and acquired valuable professional skills.

Experience in Project management:

All of the sent participants by our organization are perfectly prepared and highly motivated in the topic of the project in which they participated. The selection process of the participants from our part side is well planned in time and we are always ready with the groups earlier than necessary with the intention to have a good organization between us and our partners. We have been actively involved in all stages of youth exchanges and training courses: planning, defining roles and responsibilities of project partners, meetings, preparation, logistics, communication between all partners involved, arranging project timetables, as well as promotion of projects and dissemination of their results through our internet pages and by organizing informative sessions for the local youth for better visibility. We assist with every step of our projects – planning, defining roles and responsibilities, meetings, preparation, analysis, communication of the project itself, as well as its follows up. We share and advertise the projects on our website, blog and our social channels like Facebook, where we have 4 sub-channels- an online television, online radio, youth magazine and online newspaper. We publish photos, videos, interviews, etc. After the end of the projects, we organize some sessions with local youth and our members to ensure further dissemination and visibility of the project. After every project, we collect materials from our participants such as articles, radio interviews and videos made by them during project activities. After publishing the materials, we share them with our partners to use them as part of the dissemination of their projects.
